- ➔ Goal - zero accidents and zero pollution

- ➔ ICS is the principal international shipowners' trade association
- ➔ Membership – 40 national shipowners' associations, including UK Chamber of Shipping;
- ➔ Represents all sectors and trades, 75% of world fleet



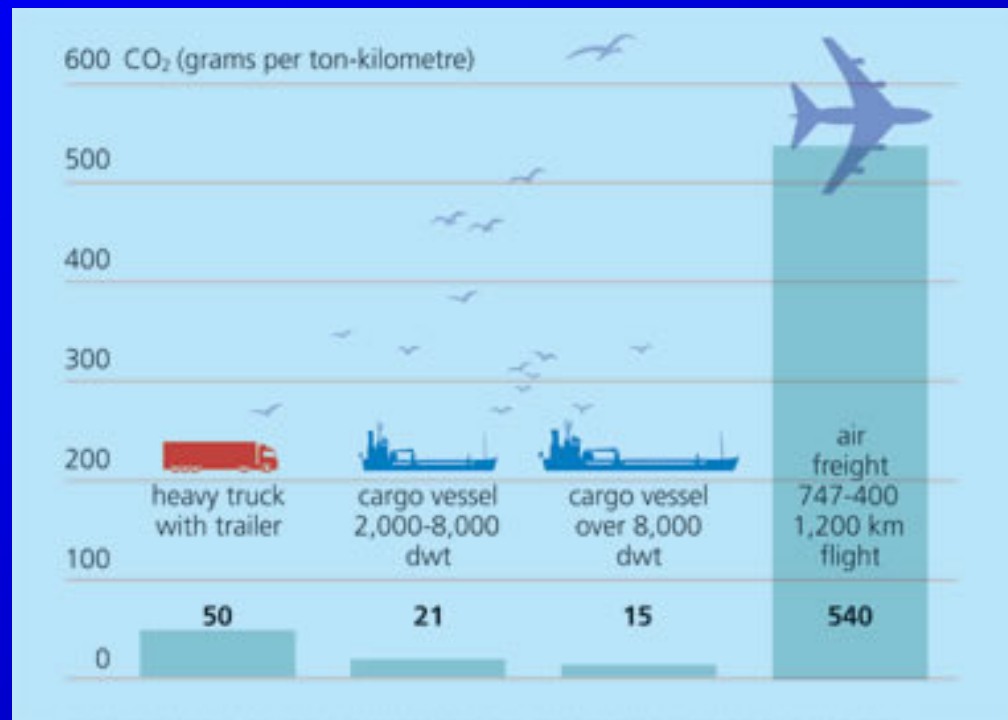

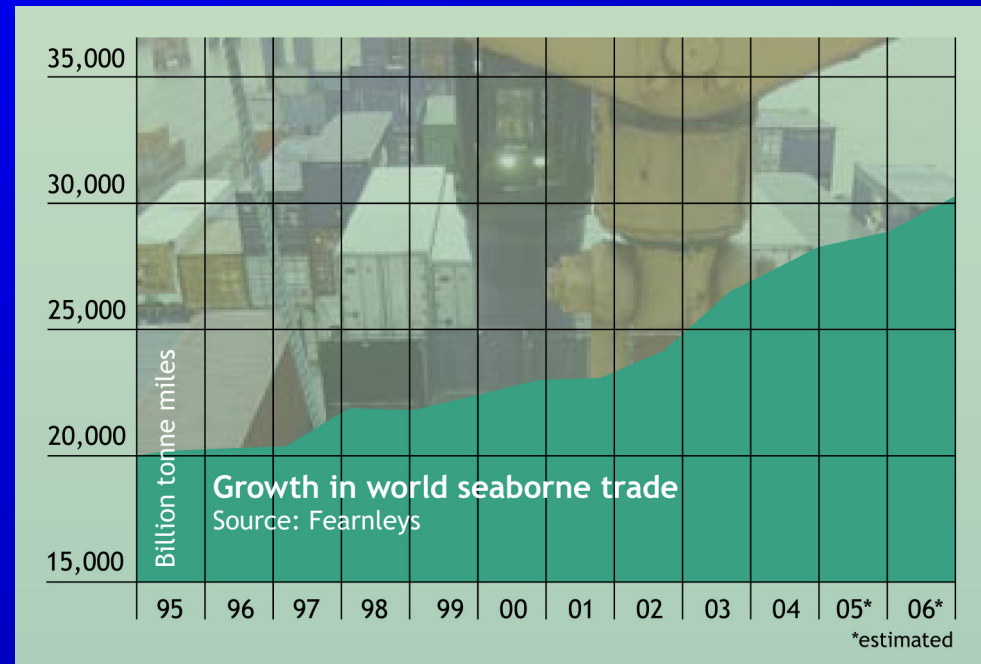




Growth in World Trade
